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First Student Canada has served Unifor with formal notice that they will lock out

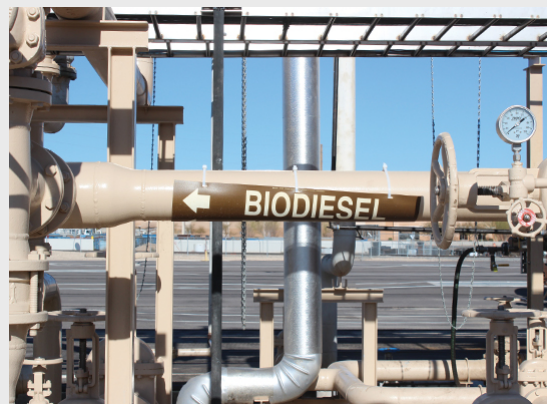
